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BOMBAY

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SIZE: -a) 44 7/8" -b) 49 5/8" finished bust measurement

UK Sizes: -a) 8-10-12 -b) 14-16-18

The model in the photograph corresponds to size -a) 8-10-12

Note: The shape of this piece is achieved when the sts are unravelled.


MATERIALS

Graph A

BOMBAY: -a) 3 -b) 3 balls col. 2030

Knitting needles	Stitches
Size 7 (U.S.)/ (4.5 mm)	Garter st (see basic instructions)
	Knit or purl through back of loop (see basic instructions) Drop st (see graph A) Join shoulders (see graph B)

R Repeat 1 knit st 1 purl st 1 YO unravel to this marker purl 1 st through back of loop knit 1 st through back of loop



GAUGE

The following measurements are taken **without** unravelling the sts.

Using size 7 needles in drop st:

25 sts & 25 rows = 4x4"

The following measurements are taken **after** unravelling the sts.

Using size 7 needles in drop st:

18 sts & 18 rows = 4x4"

BACK

Work starts at the upper part of the garment.

Cast on -a) 70 -b) 78 sts. Work 2 rows in garter st then continue working in drop st following graph A

Note: on the 1st row of graph A **increase -a)** 33 **-b)** 37 sts = the equivalent of the YO's that are added and then unravelled at the end of the work.

Total: -a) 103 -b) 115 sts.

To mark how far the sts will be unravelled to on the last row, place markers at the following measurements:

When back measures 3/4" (2 cm), measuring from the start, mark the first and last **-a**) 3 **-b**) 5 YO's at each side.

When back measures 2 3/8" (6 cm), measuring from the start, mark the next 3 YO's at each side.

When back measures $3\,7/8"$ (10 cm), measuring from the start, mark the next $3\,$ YO's at each side.

When back measures 6 1/4" (16 cm), measuring from the start, mark the next 3 YO's at each side.

When back measures 9" (23 cm), measuring from the start, mark the 3 following YO's at each side. When back measures 11 3/4" (30 cm), measuring from the start, mark the 3 central YO's. See pattern.

When back measures -a) 27 1/2" (70 cm) -b) 28" (71 cm), measuring from the start, unravel the YO's of the 1st row as far as the markers that we have been putting in the work and bind (cast off) all the sts.

Note: After unravelling the YO, **sew** the st so that it doesn't unravel to the start of the garment. Work all the YO's in the same manner.

FRONT

Work the same as the back.

FINISHING (MAKING UP)

All the seams are sewn using *side seams* (see basic instructions).

Sew the shoulders matching the letter A with A, B with B, C with C and D with D of graph B.

Sew the sides, leaving the first 5 7/8" (15 cm) **unsewn** for the side openings.

Note: The pattern shows the garment **before** the sts are unravelled, once the sts have been unravelled the width of the garment will be **-a)** 22 1/2" (57 cm) **-b)** 24 3/4" (63 cm).

Do not block or press the garment with steam.
