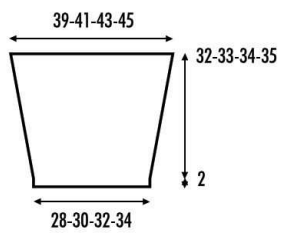
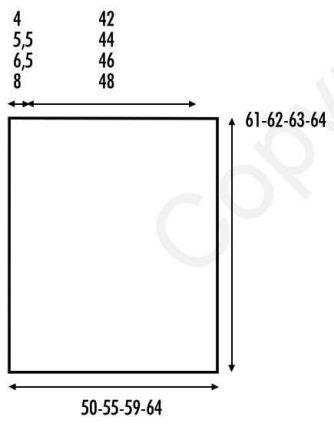

E NGLISH

SIZE: -a) 39 3/8" -b) 43 1/4" -c) 46 1/2" -d) 50 3/8",
 finished bust measurement. **UK sizes:** -a) 8-10
 -b) 12-14 -c) 16-18 -d) 20-22.

Garment in photograph corresponds to size
 -a) 8-10.

MATERIALS

BOMBAY: -a) 5 -b) 5 -c) 5 -d) 6 balls color
 2032

| Knitting needles | Stitches |
|-----------------------|--|
| Size 4 (US) or 3,5 mm | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <i>Garter st</i> (see Basic stitches) • <i>Stockinette st</i> (see Basic stitches) • <i>Pattern st</i> (see graph A) |

GAUGE

Take time to check gauge.

Using size 4 needles, in *Pattern st*:
 21 sts and 30 rows = 4x4"

BACK

Cast on -a) 105 sts -b) 117 sts -c) 123 sts
 -d) 135 sts. Work in *Garter st*.

When total height is 1 1/4" (3 cm), continue to
 work in *Pattern st* following stitch marked A in
 graph A, **maintaining** the first and the last 6 sts
 in *Garter st*, and evenly **decreasing** 6 sts along
 the 1st row. You have -a) 99 sts -b) 111 sts
 -c) 117 sts -d) 129 sts.

When total height is 7 1/8" (18 cm), on wrong
 side **decrease** 2 times K3 tog at either edge,
 at the beginning of each row. You have: -a) 95 sts
 -b) 107 sts -c) 113 sts -d) 125 sts. Continue to
 work the 2 sts at either edge in *Stockinette st*
 instead of *Garter st*.

When total height is -a) 22 7/8" (58 cm) -b) 23 1/4"
 (59 cm) -c) 23 5/8" (60 cm) -d) 24" (61 cm), con-
 tinue to work in *Garter st* over all sts.

Shoulders and neckline: When total height is
 -a) 24" (61 cm) -b) 24 3/8" (62 cm) -c) 24 3/4"
 (63 cm) -d) 25 1/4" (64 cm), **bind off (cast off)**
 all sts.

FRONT

Work same as back.

SLEEVES

Cast on -a) 58 sts -b) 64 sts -c) 68 sts -d) 72 sts.
 Work in *Garter st*.

When total height is 3/4" (2 cm), on wrong side
 evenly **decrease** 2 sts. You have: -a) 56 sts
 -b) 62 sts -c) 66 sts -d) 70 sts.

Continue to work as follows:

-a) 1 st in *Stockinette st*, 54 sts in *Pattern st*
 following stitch marked B in graph A, 1 st in
Stockinette st

-b) 1 st in *Stockinette st*, 60 sts in *Pattern st*
 following stitch marked B in graph A, 1 st in
Stockinette st

-c) 3 sts in *Stockinette st*, 60 sts in *Pattern st*
 following stitch marked B in graph A, 3 sts in
Stockinette st

-d) 2 sts in *Stockinette st*, 66 sts in *Pattern st*
 following stitch marked B in graph A, 2 sts in
Stockinette st

At the same time, at both edges increase:

-a) every 6 rows: 13 times 1 st

-b) every 6 rows: 13 times 1 st

-c) every 6 rows: 13 times 1 st

-d) alternately every 6 and 8 rows: 13 times
1 st

You have: -a) 82 sts -b) 88 sts -c) 92 sts
-d) 96 sts.

When total height is -a) 12 5/8" (32 cm) -b) 13"
 (33 cm) -c) 13 3/8" (34 cm) -d) 13 3/4" (35 cm),
bind off (cast off) all sts.

Work other sleeve in the same way.

FINISHING (MAKING UP)

Entire garment is **sewn** using *Side seam tech-*
nique (see Basic stitches).

Sew -a) 1 5/8" (4 cm) -b) 2 1/8" (5,5 cm) -c) 2 1/2"
 (6,5 cm) -d) 3 1/8" (8 cm) of shoulder seams.

Sew in sleeves, matching center of sleeve top
 to shoulder seam and the beginning of sleeves
 -a) 7 3/4" (19,5 cm) -b) 8" (20,5 cm) -c) 8 1/2"
 (21,5 cm) -d) 8 3/4" (22,5 cm) from shoulder
 seam.

Sew side and underarm seams, leaving the first
 7 1/8" (18 cm) **unsewn**.
