UK sizes: -a) 8-10 -b) 12-14 -c) 16-18 -d) 20-22.

MATERIALS

BOMBAY: -a) 5 -b) 6 -c) 6 -d) 7 balls color 2021
 3 buttons

Knitting needles	Stitches
Size 6 (4 metric)	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <i>Stockinette st</i> (See Basic Instructions) • <i>Garter st</i> (See Basic Instructions) • <i>Openwork pattern</i> (see graph A)
Crochet hook	Stitches
Size E4 (3,5 metric)	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <i>Crochet chain</i> (See Basic Instructions) • <i>Single crochet</i> (See Basic Instructions) • <i>Backwards crochet</i> (See Basic Instructions)

GAUGE

Take time to check gauge.

All measurements are taken after carefully steaming.
 Using BOMBAY with size 6 needles, in *Stockinette st*:
 23 sts and 31 rows = 4x4"

BACK

Using size 6 needles **cast on** -a) 106 sts -b) 118 sts -c) 124 sts -d) 136 sts. Work in *Openwork pattern* following graph A, beginning and ending with st marked -a) A -b) A -c) A -d) A.

After finishing 10 rows in *Openwork pattern*, work 6 rows in *Garter st* and continue working in *Stockinette st*.

Armholes:

When work measures 13" (33 cm) **bind off (cast off)** at both edges, at the beginning of each row: -a) 1 time 8 sts -b) 1 time 11 sts -c) 1 time 10 sts -d) 1 time 13 sts.

You have -a) 90 sts -b) 96 sts -c) 104 sts -d) 110 sts.

Shoulders:

When work measures -a) 20 1/2" (52 cm) -b) 20 7/8" (53 cm) -c) 21 1/4" (54 cm) -d) 21 5/8" (55 cm) **bind off (cast off)** at both edges, at the beginning of each row:

-a) 1 time 13 sts, 2 times 5 sts

-b) 1 time 13 sts, 2 times 6 sts

-c) 1 time 13 sts, 2 times 7 sts

-d) 1 time 15 sts, 2 times 7 sts

Neckline:

When work measures -a) 21 1/4" (54 cm) -b) 21 5/8" (55 cm) -c) 22" (56 cm) -d) 22 1/2" (57 cm), **bind off (cast off)** the rem -a) 44 sts -b) 46 sts -c) 50 sts -d) 52 sts.

RIGHT FRONT

Using size 6 needles **cast on** -a) 53 sts -b) 59 sts -c) 62 sts -d) 68 sts. Work in *Openwork pattern* following graph A, beginning and ending with st marked -a) B -b) B -c) C -d) C.

After finishing 10 rows in *Openwork pattern*, work 6 rows in *Garter st* and continue working in *Stockinette st*.

Armhole:

When work measures 13" (33 cm) **bind off (cast off)** at left edge, at the beginning of wrong side row: -a) 1 time 8 sts -b) 1 time 11 sts -c) 1 time 10 sts -d) 1 time 13 sts.

You have -a) 45 sts -b) 48 sts -c) 52 sts -d) 55 sts.

Neckline:

When work measures -a) 15 3/4" (40 cm) -b) 16 1/8" (41 cm) -c) 16 1/2" (42 cm) -d) 16 7/8" (43 cm), **bind off (cast off)** at right edge, at the beginning of each right side row:

-a) 1 time 12 sts, 1 time 4 sts, 3 times 2 sts

-b) 1 time 13 sts, 1 time 4 sts, 3 times 2 sts

-c) 1 time 15 sts, 1 time 4 sts, 3 times 2 sts

-d) 1 time 16 sts, 1 time 4 sts, 3 times 2 sts

Shoulder:

When work measures -a) 20 1/2" (52 cm) -b) 20 7/8" (53 cm) -c) 21 1/4" (54 cm) -d) 21 5/8" (55 cm), **bind off (cast off)** at left edge, at the beginning of each wrong side row:

-a) 1 time 13 sts, 2 times 5 sts

-b) 1 time 13 sts, 2 times 6 sts

-c) 1 time 13 sts, 2 times 7 sts

-d) 1 time 15 sts, 2 times 7 sts

Neckline:

When work measures -a) 21 1/4" (54 cm) -b) 21 5/8" (55 cm) -c) 22" (56 cm) -d) 22 1/2" (57 cm), **bind off (cast off)** the rem -a) 44 sts -b) 46 sts -c) 50 sts -d) 52 sts.

LEFT FRONT

Work same as right front, **reversing** all shaping.

SLEEVES

Using size 6 needles **cast on** -a) 58 sts -b) 64 sts -c) 68 sts -d) 74 sts. Work in *Openwork pattern* following graph A, beginning and ending with st marked -a) A -b) A -c) C -d) C.

After finishing 10 rows in *Openwork pattern*, work 6 rows in *Garter st* and continue working in *Stockinette st*.

When work measures 3 1/8" (8 cm), **increase** at both edges (= 2 sts from each edge): alternately every 4 and 6 rows: -a) 17 times 1 st -b) 16 times 1 st -c) 17 times 1 st -d) 16 times 1 st.

When work measures -a) 14 1/2" (37 cm) -b) 15" (38 cm) -c) 15 3/8" (39 cm) -d) 15 3/4" (40 cm), **bind off (cast off)** -a) 92 sts -b) 96 sts -c) 102 sts -d) 106 sts.

Work other sleeve in the same way.

SCARF

Using size 6 needles **cast on** 32 sts.

Work in *Openwork pattern* following graph A, beginning and ending with st marked C.

When work measures 70 3/4" (180 cm), **bind off (cast off)** all sts. **Note:** finish with 6 rows in *Garter st*.

FINISHING (MAKING UP)

Fold scarf in half, **baste** along outer edge and **block**. **Note:** scarf will now measure 74 3/4" (190 cm).

Match pieces and carefully **block** with steam.

All seams are sewn using *side seam technique* (see Basic Instructions).

Sew shoulder seams.

Sew in sleeve caps = matching center of sleeve top to shoulder seam and -a) 1 1/2" (3,5 cm) -b) 1 5/8" (4 cm) -c) 1 3/4" (4,5 cm) -d) 2 1/4" (5,5 cm) on each side of sleeve top to the straight edge of back and front armholes. **Block** seams.

Sew side and sleeve seams.

Using size E4 crochet hook, on right side work 1 row in *Single crochet* in the following stitch pattern: -a) 60 *Single crochet* -b) 62 *Single crochet* -c) 64 *Single crochet* -d) 66 *Single crochet* between lower edge of right front and the beginning of right front neck; -a) 34 *Single crochet* -b) 36 *Single crochet* -c) 38 *Single crochet* -d) 40 *Single crochet* between right front neck edge and shoulder seam; -a) 30 *Single crochet* -b) 32 *Single crochet* -c) 34 *Single*

crochet -d) 36 *Single crochet* along back neck; a) 34 *Single crochet* -b) 36 *Single crochet* -c) 38 *Single crochet* -d) 40 *Single crochet* along left front neck; -a) 60 *Single crochet* -b) 62 *Single crochet* -c) 64 *Single crochet* -d) 66 *Single crochet* between neck edge and lower edge of left front.

Now work another row above, in *Single crochet*.

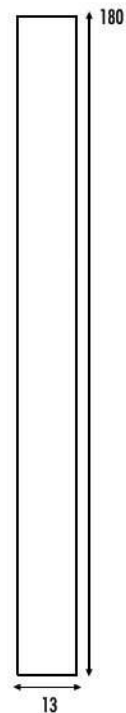
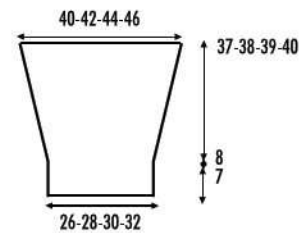
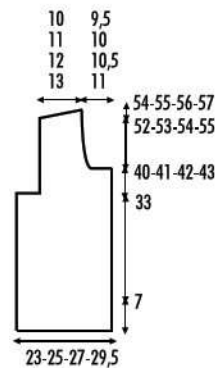
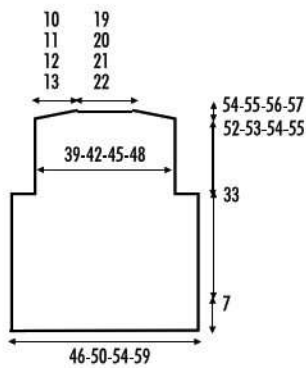
Right front buttonholes:

When you reach the right front band, just below beginning of neckline, work: -a), -b), -c), -d) 2 *Single crochet*, * ch 3, skip 2 *Single crochet* of previous row, work -a) 20 *Single crochet* -b) 21 *Single crochet* -c) 22 *Single crochet* -d) 23 *Single crochet* *, repeat from * to * -a), -b), -c), -d) 1 more time, ch 3, skip 2 *Single crochet* of previous row, work -a), -b), -c), -d) 12 *Single crochet*. **Cut** yarn and **weave in** ends.

Using size E4 crochet hook, on right side work 1 row *Backwards crochet* above the last row in *Single crochet*, beginning at lower edge of left front. **Note:** work 2 *Backwards crochet* in the ch 3 of right front buttonholes. **Cut** yarn and **weave in** ends.

Block crochet edging.

Sew buttons to left front band, opposite buttonholes.
